

Rocklin Fine Arts 2025 RFA - Jarrett Student Art Show

The RFA-Jarrett Student Art Show is on Saturday, May 3 from noon to 5 pm and Sunday, May 4, from noon to 4 pm in the Springview Hall Community Center 5480 5th Street, Rocklin, CA 95677. The Student Artist Reception is on Sunday, May 4 from 2 pm to 4 pm. Awards will be presented at the Student Show Reception on Sunday, May 4, at 3:00 PM, followed by the raffle drawing at 3:30 PM.

TO ENTER: Complete the online entry form found at **www.rocklinfinearts.org** and upload your image as instructed.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries & images must be received by **MIDNIGHT, Thursday, April 10, 2025. ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all students of Placer County in grades K through 12.

ELIGIBLE WORK: Artwork must be original and done solely by the student in a media of the student's choice. Entries must be appropriate for viewing by all ages (G-Rated). **Non-original classwork, giclée and/or prints** (unless photos or digitally created art) **are not acceptable.**

MEDIA used may be, but is not limited to, the following:

OIL, ACRYLIC, WATERCOLOR, PASTEL, PENCIL, CHARCOAL, PEN & INK, COLORED PENCIL, MIXED MEDIA, ALCOHOL INK, ENCAUSTIC, CASEIN, PHOTOGRAPHY, FIBER ART, CERAMIC, FUSED & BLOWN GLASS, 3D & SCULPTURE, DIGITALLY ALTERED PHOTOGRAPHS, DIGITALLY CREATED ART. A work of art generated entirely by AI, without any human input, is not eligible.

Artwork Identification: Securely fasten an ID Label with the following information to the back (or bottom) of your artwork. You may print one out from the web or fill one out at receiving. Print neatly

2D Size and Display Requirements:

Elementary School	Paintings/Photos no larger than 11" x17", mounted on black construction		
(Grades K-6)	paper. RFA will provide paper and mount your artwork as needed. May also be		
	matted or framed with wire hanger (no sawtooth hangers).		
Middle/High School (Grades 7-9)	Paintings/Photos no larger than 16"x20" or upon request, matted or framed. Frames must have wire hangers (no sawtooth hangers).		
High School (Grades 10-12)	Paintings/Photos no larger than 24"x24" or upon request, matted or framed. Frames must have wire hangers (no sawtooth hangers).		

3D Size Requirements:

• Sculpture or 3D art must be able to be displayed on a pedestal, tabletop, or floor, and cannot exceed 25 pounds or have dimensions greater than W: 2 ft x L: 2 ft x H: 6 ft.

AWARDS: First, Second, and Third Place award ribbons and certificates will be given in four categories: Grades K-3, Grades 4-6, Grades 6-9, and Grades 10-12. Awards will be presented following the Student Artist Reception on Sunday, May 4, 2025 at 3:00 PM followed by the raffle drawing.

ENTRY FEES: None. Entry is free, one entry per student.

IMAGES:

- File Format: Send a .JPG (jpeg). or .PNG (ping) formatted in RGB (red/green/blue) color.
- File Resolution: 300 dpi (dots per inch). Each image will have an enlarged close-up view, so the original image you send needs to be high resolution.
- File Size: a file size range of 1.5 MB to 3 MB is good for online purposes.
- **Crop** images to a rectangle that does not include extraneous background, matting, or frame.
- Use appropriate lighting to avoid glares. Thin vertical images do not show well online.
- Cell phone images are fine if sent at highest resolution (usually 3 MB).

Firstname_Lastname_ArtTitle.jpg No spaces between words, no special characters. For example, an image of **Starry Night** submitted by **Vincent Van Gogh** would be saved in .jpg format and named **Vincent VanGogh StarryNight.jpg**.

- Bring your Artwork on Thursday, May 1, 2025, between 1:00 pm and 5:00 pm to Springview Hall Community Center - 5480 5th Street, Rocklin, CA 95677
- Artwork must be **picked up** between **4:00 pm and 5:00 pm on Sunday, May 4, 2025**, following the Student Show Reception.
- Note that these dates and times for artwork delivery and pickup apply to hand-delivered art by individual students for the Student Art Show. Some Rocklin USD schools may collect student artwork and arrange in advance for RFA to pick up and delivery from the school site.
- All RFA-Jarrett Student Art Show will be on display **Saturday, May 3 and Sunday, May 4,** in Springview Hall.
- The RFA-Jarrett Scholarship and Student Show Awards will be presented at the Student Show Reception on Sunday, May 4 at 3:00 PM, followed by the raffle drawing at 3:30 PM.
- First Place artwork from each grade level group will be displayed in the Rocklin Library during the month of May.
